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VIEWS OF KISTVAENS, ROUNDHILL.

FORTY-FOURTH REPORT ON BARROWS.

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KISTVAENS ON ROUND HILL AND BY BLACKABROOK, NEAR PRINCETOWN.

In Vol. XLIV (Exeter, 1919) of our *Transactions* I published plans of seven kistvaens, six of which lie north of the Blackabrook, and on the slopes of Round Hill. During the past year I have photographed these six kistvaens, and I now offer these views by way of report.

Fig. 1, Plate I, shows the kistvaen, the plan of which forms Plate II in our 31st Report, the map reference is six inch O.S. Devon. Sheet CII N.W., lon. 3° 57′ 29½″ W.,

lat. 50° 32′ 41″ N.

Fig. 2, Plate I, shows the kistvaen, the plan of which forms Plate III of our 31st Report, the reference is CII N.W. position with reference to last named, as shown in key plan on Plate III (31st Report).

Fig. 3, Plate I, shows the kistvaen, the plan of which

forms Plate IV of our 31st Report, reference as last.

Fig. 1, Plate II, the kistvaen planned on Plate V of 31st Report, reference CVII N.W., lon. 3° 57′ 51½″ W., lat. 50° 33′ 0″ N.

Fig. 2, Plate II, the kistvaen planned on Plate VI of 31st Report, reference CVII N.W., lon. 3° 57′ 37″ W.,

lat. 50° 33′ 8½″ N.

Fig. 3, Plate II, the kistvaen planned on Plate VII of 31st Report, reference CVII N.W., lon. 3° 57′ $42\frac{1}{4}$ ″ W., lat. 50° 33′ $9\frac{1}{2}$ ″ N.
